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
India's 5 million sanitation workers (half of them are women) are the most vulnerable front line workers

Sanitation work is considered as 'dirty' and done only by the Scheduled Castes (Dalits) for centuries

Being a sanitation worker means – facing social stigma, untouchability, indignity, oppression and sexual harassment – generation after generation




Types of sanitation workers in liquid waste management

Types of sanitation workers in solid waste management



ISSUES FACED BY SANITATION WORKERS




Vulnerability and insecurity increases with nature of employment

- Possible contamination of wastewater and sewage




HOW CIVIL SOCIETY RESPONDED TO EXACT ACCOUNTABILITY
